Current certificate of insurance naming the School District, and Dickinson Hussman Architects. as additional insured shall be issued upon notice to proceed. 5% Bid bonds will be required with the bid along with Performance and Payment Bonds with the successful bidder. Insurance certificates shall include automobile, workers' compensation, and general liability coverage. The Owner may accept or reject any and all bids for any reason.

The work consists of upgrading the food service area including installation of new food service equipment, architectural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection work.
